



- Following up on dependencies and potential bottlenecks.




Event Project Network Diagram




Project Activity Network Diagram

Software Project Network Diagram



Network Diagram Showing Project Schedule Management Plan


This slide covers the project network diagram which helps the project team members to control the project schedule. It also includes the dependencies and estimated duration of the project.

- Internal projects, administrative projects, and functional projects are all examples of business projects.


Business Project Network Diagram One Page Summary

This one pager visualizes the summary of network flowchart diagram of business projects. It depicts the sequence of project management activities, team organizational process, and website development network diagram.


Project Management Action Plan Network Diagram

Gantt Chart vs Network Diagram



What is the significance of the project management schedule plan?

- The primary goal of project scheduling is to represent the plan for completing the project scope on time.
- In its most basic form, a project schedule could be a chart of work elements with associated schedule dates of when work elements and milestones (usually the completion of a deliverable) are expected to occur.

What is the function of a network diagram?

- A network diagram is a graphical representation of a computer or telecommunications network.
- It depicts the network's components and how they interact, such as routers, devices, hubs, firewalls, and so on.

What is the purpose of an arrow diagram?

Because each node represents a task within your project, an activity on arrow diagram is the most commonly used in project management. The length of the arrows connecting the nodes represents how long each task takes. As a result, the

longer the arrow, the longer the task.

What are the various kinds of network diagrams?

- In project management, there are two types of network diagrams: arrow diagramming method (ADM), also known as "activity network diagram" or "activity on arrow," and precedence diagramming method (PDM), also known as "node network" or "activity on node."
